Important reminders to help you get started!

All Band Members

- 1. Make sure you are in our Google Classroom.
- 2. Bring to every class (in-person & virtual): instrument, pencil, & folder.
- 3. All students are required to purchase "Habits of a Successful Middle School Musician."
